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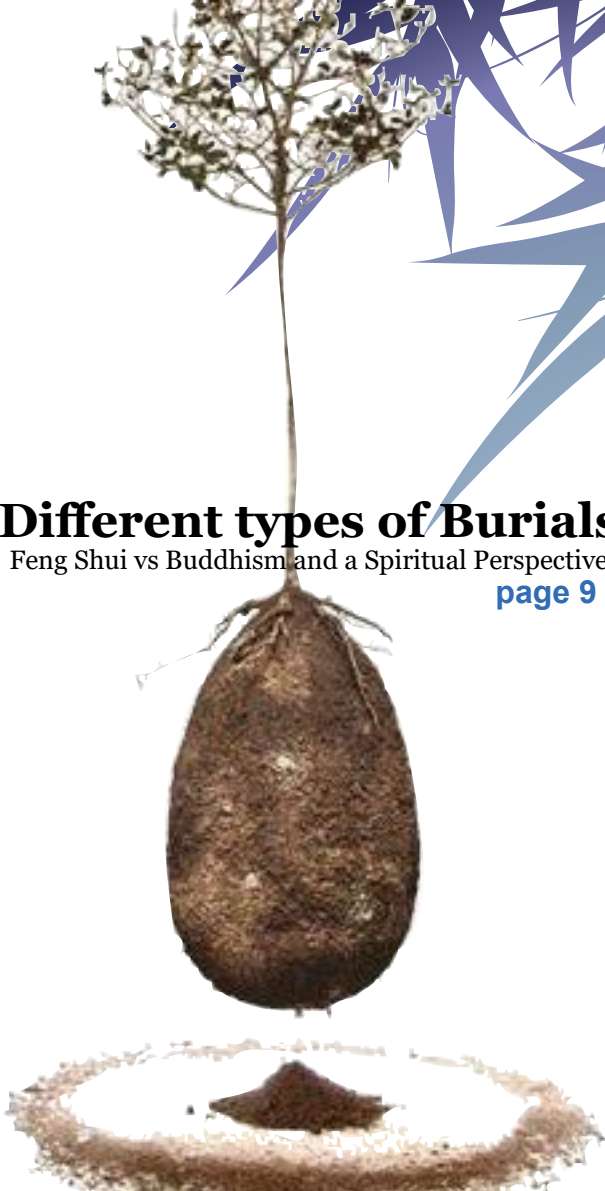

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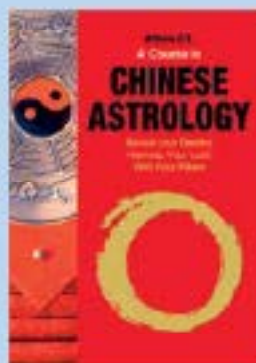

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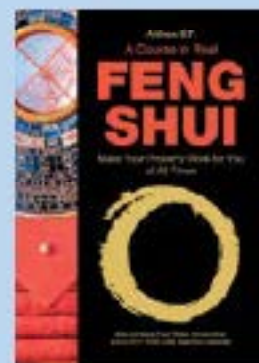

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Things to take note of during the Qingming Festival

The Qingming Festival is a traditional Chinese festival where the family commemorates deceased relatives by cleaning their tombs and ensuring that the tombs are in good condition. Qingming Festival is also known as the Tomb Sweeping Day. According to folklore, when a person passes away, his three souls will leave the body. One goes to heaven, the second goes to the grave and the third stays at the ancestral tablet in the home to watch over the descendants. The descendants worship and perform prayers at home as a sign of respect and also to feed the soul of the ancestors. In Feng Shui study, it is believed that the condition of tombs and their surroundings affects the living descendants' health and wealth.

Qingming Festival, which usually falls on the 15th day after the Spring Equinox, happens to fall on April 5 this year. Most people will observe these rites either on the day itself or 10 days before or after April 5, which fall in between March 26 and April 13.

Below are some interesting practices during the Tomb Sweeping Day. You can choose to follow some of these practices but do take note of No. 2, 3 and 7.

1. Joking is prohibited during prayers at the tomb. It is believed that joking will incur the wrath of the ancestors. Although this is a myth, Chinese culture pays a lot of importance to respecting the elders and ancestors, hence, every family should keep a serious

expression while praying to the ancestors. Family should be dressed in neat and clean clothes to show respect for the ancestors.

2. It is a good time to check for any damage to the tombs. Any damage should be repaired as soon as possible. Weeds and stagnant water surrounding the tombs should also be cleared away. In Feng Shui study, these can bring ill fortune to the descendants such as poor health and poor luck. Traditionally, descendants visit their ancestors' graves during Qingming Festival to pray for protection and blessings.



3. It is best to do tomb sweeping before 3 p.m. in the afternoon to avoid absorbing Yin energy. Too much Yin energy is not good for the health. Burial grounds and graveyards are considered Yin places full of Yin energy. It is best to visit during the day when there is an abundance of Yang energy.

4. Eating red eggs a day or two before the Qingming festival can bring good luck to the family. Although this is a practice based on myth and superstition, there is no harm trying. Nine hard-boiled eggs are prepared and the shells of the eggs dyed a red colour. The eggs are placed in the living room from 12 p.m. until late afternoon and then served to the family. It is believed that this will strengthen Yang Qi and in turn boost career, health and wealth luck.



5. Another practice based on myth and superstition is the practice of placing willow branches at the door during the Qingming Festival. It is believed that this can help to fend off calamity or negative effects throughout the year. This will also lead the soul of ancestors home so that descendants can pay their respects to them.

6. It is believed that placing willow branches in the bedroom, living room or office can bring youthfulness and longevity. Willow branches are used to ensure longevity, ward off evil spirits and eliminate toxic substances during this festival. The willow branches are believed to be an effective way to invoke the god of Beauty to bestow good appearance and longevity.



7. Pregnant women are discouraged from tomb sweeping. During the old days, tombs were located in far away mountainous areas. It was taxing for pregnant women to travel to the tomb. Furthermore, Yin energy is regarded as unhealthy, hence, pregnant women were discouraged from tomb sweeping.

Asking for protection during the Qingming Rites

Different types of Burials

Feng Shui vs Buddhism and a Spiritual Perspective

In the olden days, Chinese culture placed a lot of importance in the institution of family, lineage, and clan. These entities are simply called “Jiāzú 家族” in Chinese. It can be summed-up as family and clan. It was therefore important that each family had many children to carry on the family surname and flourish, especially the eldest son who is in the direct line of succession from the ancestors. This was further enforced by the teachings of Confucius and the practices of Taoism. The aim of Yin Feng Shui then was to ensure that good Qi benefited the “Jiazu,” or living descendants. Yin House Feng Shui was widely used by rich families and the Emperors of China. Emperors who used Yin House Feng Shui hoped to leave behind a legacy or a dynasty that lasts forever so that their good deeds can be remembered forever.

Choosing the burial ground was tedious work. It involved considering a big piece of land, finding the meridian spot and tapping into the good energy. It was very different from selecting a readymade plot in a memorial park.

In modern times, loving parents who want the best for their children and grandchildren, will engage Feng Shui consultants to select a good plot at the memorial park. Most of the time, these plots only tap into the energy from the mountain and water features of the surrounding environment, which is very different from burial on a meridian spot.

Feng Shui came about and evolved around the same time as Taoism and Confucianism. Although Feng Shui is not part of any religion, its concepts and practices have been absorbed into Taoist and Confucian practices.

Taoists believe in living in harmony with the Tao, or “The Way of Heaven.” For some Taoist practitioners, Feng Shui is a tool to cultivate a life of harmony by living in harmony with the environment. Confucianism teaches filial piety and respect for elders, parents and ancestors. It places importance on “Jiazu” living in harmony. Thus, burying elders who pass away on a plot of land with good Feng Shui was seen as an act of filial piety to honour ancestors for giving life to the family lineage. They believe that there is a link between the generations that transcend death.

In the teachings of the Buddha, everyone has a Buddha in them. One can achieve enlightenment by giving up the world and leading a holy life or by freeing oneself from lust, cravings and desires. All of us will pass away eventually as part of the natural process of birth, old-age and death, thus we should always keep in mind the impermanence of life. Death is not the end of life, but merely the end of soul or spirit in the body in this life. Through this process, a person will eventually achieve enlightenment when they finally understand the concept of detachment.

A popular spiritual concept is that after death the soul detaches from the body and goes towards the light.



Ground Burial

Ground burial is the most traditional burial option available. This is where Yin House Feng Shui principles can be applied. From a Feng Shui perspective, it is also the best choice if one's intention is to benefit one's descendants.

When a person dies, the Qi that is associated with him or her does not vanish. Qi is a form of energy. Energy cannot be created or destroyed but merely transformed from one state to another. When the person's remains return to the earth, the Qi of the person will be emitted at a certain frequency. This frequency can be

picked up by the person's family members or those who share his bloodline irrespective of where they are. In modern terms, this is known as "DNA signature." Yin House Feng Shui principles are applied to optimize the Qi of the deceased. When the burial is done at a location that is rich in positive Qi, the frequency generated will impact those who share his bloodline positively.

Sky Burial

Sky burial is a Tibetan funeral practice in which a human corpse is placed on a mountaintop to decompose while exposed to the elements or to be eaten by scavenging animals, especially carrion birds. The majority of Tibetan people and many Mongols adhere to Vajrayana Buddhism, which teaches the transmigration of spirits, where there is no need to preserve the body which becomes an empty vessel when a person passes away. The Sky burial represents an act of compassion and generosity, allowing animals to feed on the dead body which no longer has a function, as a way of giving back to nature. For the deceased, sky burial can be a spiritual process of acceptance and detachment, so that one's soul naturally moves toward higher dimensions. From a Feng Shui perspective, it is not a good choice if one's intention is to benefit one's descendants.



Cremation

Cremation is the disposal of a deceased's body by burning the body at a high temperature to ashes. The family of the deceased can place the ashes in an urn at a columbarium or scatter



them according to the deceased's wishes. Cremation is believed to be a better choice of burial for people who are into spirituality. Cremation helps the soul to recognize, accept and detach from the body faster. The soul can then move on. Many high ranking Buddhist monks choose to be cremated and have their ashes buried.

A cremation permanently destroys all traces of an individual's DNA. The positive Qi of the columbarium will not benefit the descendants of the deceased.

Hanging Coffins

Hanging coffins are coffins which have been placed on cliffs. It is an ancient burial custom of the Bo ethnic group of southern China. Yin House Feng Shui can be applied to this type of burial. A prosperous vein on the right mountains can be selected for placement of the coffins.

Capsula Mundi

Capsula Mundi is a modern burial popularised by Italian designers Anna Citelli and Raoul Bretzela. It is an egg-shaped pod, an ancient and perfect form for the deceased's place of burial. It is made of a biodegradable material that can nourish a tree planted on top of it. The tree is chosen by the deceased.

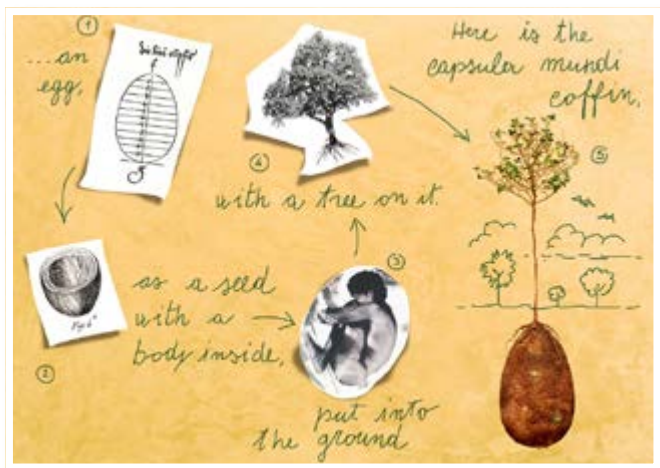


While this type of burial will not help the soul move forward faster, its concept stems from the compassion and generous intention to give back to nature.

From a Feng Shui aspect, it is not beneficial to the descendants of the deceased and it may have some negative impact on them. Read, "What to Avoid in Yin House Feng Shui" to find out why.

Handling all the details of a funeral, death and dying can be an expensive business. Planning the choice of burial and funeral service in advance is a wise thing to do. Whatever choice of burial, the soul of the deceased will rest in peace and move forward to the path of enlightenment.

Those who may not get to ensure the best burials for the good of the descendants due to budget limitations, can find comfort in the belief of a higher power who will watch over their descendants.



Date Selection for Burial

Since ancient times, people believed that the souls of the dead lived on in another world, the netherworld, while maintaining an earthly presence at the site of their graves. Traditionally funerals were grand ceremonies for the purpose of seeing off the dead. During the funeral service, everyone must mourn as loudly as possible and wear mourning clothes to show sadness. Women wore white pointed hoods, while men wore white headbands.

The funeral ceremony lasts for 49-days with prayers said every seven days. It could last even longer if the deceased was waiting for the eldest son to return to have a last look before the coffin was sealed. Traditional Chinese burial customs were greatly influenced by Confucianism, Taoism and Buddhism. In Confucian philosophy, paying one's respects to one's ancestors is an act of filial piety. Influenced by Confucianism and Taoism, many Chinese believe that the souls of the dead stay on to protect their descendants. Thus, families will seek the help of Taoist monks to select a suitable auspicious date for burial. Sometimes the family will delay the burial in order to hold the burial on an auspicious date if no auspicious dates were immediately available.

Today, funerals are much more simple and economical. And the funeral ceremony has been shortened to between 3 to 5 days. However, it is still important to select an auspicious date for the burial.

The classical text says that "The vein of the earth provides good fortune but it is the timing that triggers the positive effect." (發福由其地脈，催福出於良辰)

First, take note of the days before the

astronomical events below which are unusable for burial.

Vernal Equinox
Summer Solstice
Autumnal Equinox
Winter Solstice
Coming of Spring

In terms of Feng Shui, the burial is important not only as a sign of respect and filial piety to the deceased, but also for its Feng Shui implications on the family and its future generations. It is important that an auspicious date is chosen by an expert to ensure that everything is in harmony.

At the basic level, a suitable day is selected from the "12 Day Officers." Table 1 shows which of the 12 Day Officers are suitable, those that are okay and those that should be avoided.

It is important to avoid the inauspicious stars below for the burial day;

Besides this, it is essential that the day selected must not clash with the birth Year Branch of the deceased (refer to Reference Table: Bazi Earthly Branches Relationship on page 99 for the Branches Clash-Relationship).

The day is also not usable if it clashes with the birth Year Branch of the principal bereaved person. In the old days, that person would be the eldest son or the next of kin who will take care of the grave and offer prayers to the deceased. Nowadays, this person is usually the one who foots the bills.

If possible, the date selected should also be personalized to the deceased. With the shorter funeral ceremonies, personalized dates for the deceased is a luxury option only for the rich. As long as it is an auspicious day with no clash with the birth Year Branch of the deceased, it is good enough.



A Spiritual and Superstitious Emperor

The Mausoleum of the First Qin Emperor (Qin Shi Huang) is located in Lintong District, Xi'an, Shaanxi province of China. This mausoleum is situated underneath a 76-meter-tall tomb shaped like a truncated pyramid. The layout of the mausoleum is modelled on the Qin capital Xianyang, and divided into inner and outer cities. The mausoleum is one of the largest underground mausoleums in the world with the inner city spanning 2.5 km and the outer city spanning 6.3 km.

There were many conspiracy theories on why the Qin Shi Huang Mausoleum has bad Feng Shui. Stories had been spread that the Feng Shui Master employed by Qin Shi Huang lacked Feng Shui knowledge. Others believed that the Feng Shui Master selected a bad plot for Qin Shi Huang out of hatred for his tyranny. However, the simpler explanation could be that the use of Feng Shui at the time was still in its infancy. Thus, it is not surprising that the Qin Shi Huang Mausoleum was not built in accordance to

auspicious Feng Shui principles.

Qin Shi Huang was spiritual and extremely superstitious. He was believed to have sent Xu Fu, an alchemist and spiritual master, to seek the elixir of life. He also sent an alchemist to destroy Nanjing using black magic. People who came up with the conspiracy theories may have been born many generations later when Feng Shui had been popularised by Taoist Monks. They may have mistakenly believed that the spiritual masters of the Qin Dynasty were also well-versed in Feng Shui.

In fact the placement of the Qin Shi Huang Mausoleum followed the hierarchy of imperial family according to the “Book of Rites” (礼记) And “Erya” (尔雅). The selection of the location of his mausoleum may not be based on any Feng Shui principles. First of all, the establishment of the location of the mausoleum is not unrelated to the location of the tombs of previous Qin monarchs. Qin Shi Huang’s ancestors and the Empress

Dowager were buried in Zhangzhe County to the West of the Zhiyang area. The Qin Shi Huang Mausoleum was placed at the peak of Lishan, in the East of Zhiyang. It followed the order as stated in the "Book of Rites." The Book of Rites is a collection of texts describing social forms, administration, and ceremonial rites heavily influenced by Confucian teachings and principles.

According to the Book of Rites, South, North and West are for the elders, while the Southwest direction is for younger people. The book, "Lun Heng" of the Eastern Han

a moving dragon, and there are no table mountains facing the tomb to mellow out and collect the Qi. It faces a wide open space that results in Qi being dispersed. There is no protector mountain behind his tomb and no meridian spot. History confirms the bad Feng Shui of the tomb. Shortly after Qin Shi Huang's death, the Qin Empire came to an end. His only son sat on the Qin Empire throne for only 4 years as a puppet king. The Empire was overthrown by a revolution that would later give rise to the Han Dynasty.

Besides, from the wealth and warriors



explained this in even more detail. "The West is for the husband and the elderly, as a form of respect. While the younger generation are placed in the East." Furthermore, Empress Xuan wished to be buried in between her husband and son. Thus, following the principles of the Book of Rites, the correct location for Qin Shi Huang's Mausoleum is in the East of Zhiyang.

Qin Shi Huang's tomb was placed under

placed in his mausoleum, Qin Shi Huang was preparing his life in the Netherworld. He was sure to live again in another realm to fight his war. Although his empire had fallen, he is still remembered as the first Emperor of China in spite of the inauspicious Feng Shui of his tomb. This came about from his own sheer willpower and strong intentions, as well as his ambition to succeed.

Besides being the first Emperor of China, he

was also known:

1. For uniting the six states during the Warring Period. He brought 400 years of civil war to an end. He ensured that the power of feudal lords will never tear China apart again.
2. As a ruthless ruler. Under his rule, the Qin killed about 1,500,000 people.
3. For uniting the Chinese writing system. He was heavily criticized for ordering the mass burning of books and execution of scholars.
4. For building the largest mausoleum in the world. He was heavily criticized for the hardship caused by its construction. Many people died.
5. For building the Great Wall of China even though he was not the one who started it

and not the one who completed it. Similar to the above, he was criticized for the hardship caused during its construction which resulted in the deaths of many labourers.

There is continuous debate as to whether he should be remembered as a hero or a villain. There is no definite answer to this question, but he has proven that strong will and intention can bring you very far.



A Brief History of 郭璞 Guo Pu, the founding father of Feng Shui

Guo Pu is the author of The Book of Burial. He is the first person to write the most authoritative source of Feng Shui doctrine. The Book of Burial is the first book to address the concept of Feng Shui in the history of China. Guo Pu is known as the father of Feng Shui Principles.

Guo Pu was a Taoist mystic, geomancer, collector of strange tales, editor of old texts, and erudite commentator. A native of Wenxi County, in what is now southwest Shanxi Province, Guo Pu was the well-educated son of a governor. He was a natural historian and a prolific writer of the Jin dynasty.

Guo Pu studied Taoism, occultism and fortune telling in his youth. He later worked as a fortune teller for various local officials and leaders. He used his knowledge to interpret omens and signs in order to predict the success or failure of various endeavours for those officials. Guo Pu's family relocated to the south of the Yangtze River, settling in Jiankang (modern Nanjing) during the Xiongnu clan invasion in AD307. Guo Pu served as an omen-interpreter to military leaders and the Eastern Jin chancellor Wang Dao before being appointed to official court positions. In 323 Guo joined warlord Wang

Dun who controlled much of the modern Hunan and Hubei area. He was executed in 324 after he failed to produce a favorable omen for Wang's plan to usurp the throne of the Eastern Jin.

Guo Pu was likely the most learned person of his era. He was one of the foremost commentators on ancient Chinese works. He wrote commentaries to the Chu Ci, Shan Hai Jing, Mu Tianzi Zhuan, Fangyan, Erya, Sima Xiangru's "Fu on the Excursion Hunt of the Son of Heaven", and three ancient dictionaries: Cang Jie, Yuanli, and Boxue. In Guo Pu's commentaries, he identified and explained rare words and allusions. He made classical texts that survived in their original form comprehensible to modern readers.

Guo was also an accomplished poet, and his 11 surviving fu poems display his extensive command of the ancient Chinese language.

Prosperity Live Burial

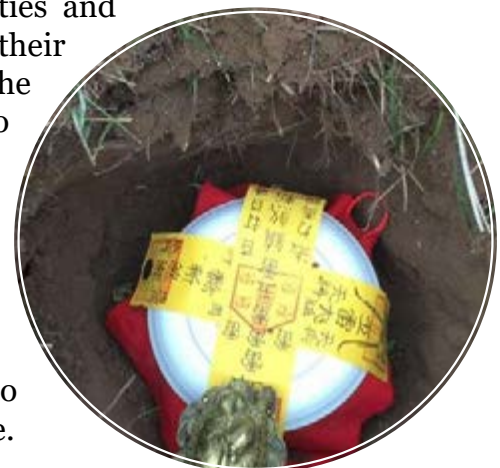

Prosperity Live Burial is the use of one's DNA to directly tap into the Feng Shui of the land to reap immediate positive Qi. It sounds mystical and mysterious to many. However, it works similarly to Yin House Feng Shui. Where Yin House Feng Shui (refer to the article on page 10, paragraph 1 to find out how Yin House Feng Shui works) uses the DNA of a deceased ancestor to tap into the Feng Shui of the land, Prosperity Live Burial uses a living person's DNA. This DNA is extracted from the body in the form of a lock of hair, skin, blood, teeth, nails, or clothing together with birthday characters and then buried in a good location on selected auspicious dates and times in order to transfer Good Qi to the person and enhance his fortune. In such cases, the person is tapping into the Yang House Qi and Yin House Qi of a positive landform.

It all started in Guo Pu's published findings, the Book of Burial. Guo Pu found that by getting the right energy from the land via what is known as the Dragon vein, one can change or improve one's destiny or luck. In the Book of Burial, the Yin House Feng Shui technique is only applied to the deceased or ancestors of the family.

However, along the way it might have been improvised to suit the needs of people who may not have their ancestors buried in the right place or orphans who do not know their ancestors or those whose ancestor's grave are badly located. Rather than carrying out the tedious work of reburying their ancestors, they may opt for the Prosperity Live Burial. The Prosperity Live Burial has some elements of Taoist practices.

With heavy responsibilities and constant threats to their rule, it is believed that the Emperors of China also applied the Prosperity Live Burial to ensure good health, cultivate longevity, secure their authority and promote wealth luck. However, there are no records to prove that this is the case.





This Chinese tradition has been long carried out by wealthy families in Taiwan and Hong Kong. It has recently grown popular in Southeast Asia with the mushrooming of Memorial Parks.

What is the Purpose of a Prosperity Live Burial?

The original purpose of the Prosperity Live Burial is to tap into the internal earth energies to help one who is seriously ill to regain good health. Those who have had the Prosperity Live Burial ritual performed often claim that they experienced much faster recovery from illnesses. These days, the purpose of applying the Prosperity Live Burial is to enhance descendant luck, wealth, business success, career promotion, educational achievements, authority and marriage.

Benefits of the Prosperity Live Burial

Some of the benefits of prosperity live burial are:

1. Swift recovery from illness
2. Healing a person's physical and mental health
3. Success in career and wealth
4. To promote longevity
5. Recovery from setbacks in life i.e. bankruptcy
6. Avoiding serious accidents or life and death situations
7. To protect a person against people with malicious intents
8. Getting out of major legal entanglements
9. Opening doors of opportunity for amassing wealth

Who should or can do a Prosperity Live Burial?

Anyone can do this. There are no restrictions on this and it depends on your needs and wants. As a consultant, usually I'll pull out a Qi Men chart to double check if it works and whether the chosen plot of land truly enhances that person's luck.

Should you do it?

Why not?

What to Avoid in Yin House Feng Shui

From a Feng Shui aspect, a ground burial (Yin House) has a direct impact on the descendants of the deceased. To ensure harmony and good tidings for the descendants, the following actions should be avoided.

a) Avoid fencing up the tomb

Families who prefer privacy may decide to erect a wall or fence around the tomb. Do not do so unless the tomb is located in a big space with acres of land. An enclosed tomb will eventually lead to legal entanglements and prison.



b) Avoid planting flowering plants on top of the burial ground.

Some creative families may want to decorate the tomb with flowers. Usually cut flowers are placed in vases to honour the ancestors. Some people go a step further by planting flowers right on top of the burial



ground. This can cause the descendants to have unstable relationships plagued with scandals and peach blossom entanglements.

c) Avoid planting a big tree right on top or near the burial ground



Planting a big tree right on top of the burial ground is also a “No-No.”. The roots of the tree can destroy the coffin and the tomb stone and wrap themselves around the remains. Sha Qi arises when the roots of a sturdy tree penetrates into the coffin. As a result, family members may suffer health problems, especially those related to the heart.

From a Feng Shui perspective, the Capsula Mundi burial may eventually bring similar health problems to family members.

d) Avoid cementing the whole tomb.

For purpose of easy maintenance, the family may decide to have the whole tomb cemented instead of planting grass on top of it. This can lead to health issues for the descendants.

e) Not fill up the tomb to form a mount

The soil on the tomb should not be concave. It should be immediately filled up with soil into the shape of a small mound. A concave

tomb will collect water. This can become a form of Sha Qi. Again it will lead to health issues related to the lungs, such as coughs, bronchitis or lung complications.

f) Sitting of the tomb clashes with the Grand Duke

Avoid burial if the sitting of the tomb falls in a clashing direction with the year's Grand Duke. For example, in 2018 the Grand Duke is located at the Northwest 1. If the tomb sits at Southeast 1, it is considered to be clashing with the Grand Duke. It is deemed to be very inauspicious for burials. In such cases, special Yin Feng Shui methods need to be employed to avert disasters falling on the deceased's families.

g) Not noticing changes in the colour of the tombstone

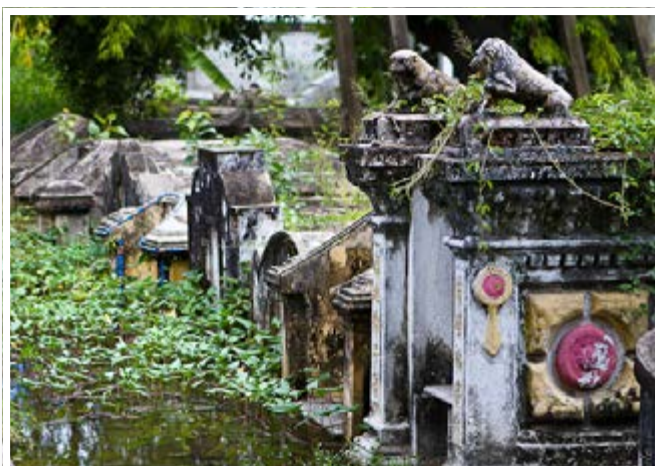
The colour of the tombstone can sometimes indicate the health of the Qi in the tomb. Black or greyish tombstones can indicate underground flooding near the grave or a flooded tomb. Take note of the colour of the tombstone during Qing Ming when you go for ancestor worship and cleaning of the tomb. Paint the tombstone. If the colour of the tombstone changes shortly after the paint job, this is an indication of water Sha Qi. This can result in family quarrels,

broken relationships, health issues and bankruptcy. The solution is to collect the bones for reburial elsewhere.

h) Cracks on the Tombstone

Cracks appearing on tombstones may result in family arguments, broken relationships, illnesses or financial troubles. Small cracks can be repaired easily. A large crack can be serious, resulting in death in the family. It must be refurbished immediately.

i) Water Sha Qi



A puddle of water nearby or in the front of the tombstone may bring illness to the descendants.



The above tomb has several serious problems. The overgrown plants destroyed much of the tomb area resulting in serious cracks. The tomb discolouration show negative Qi. The cemented mound at the back of the tomb is a “No-no.”

The Search for the Rising Phoenix Meridian Spot

Wu Zetian was a Chinese sovereign who ruled during the brief Zhou dynasty. She is officially recognized as the only woman Emperor of China in more than two millennia. The old Chinese historians had mixed views on Wu Zetian. She was admired for her abilities in governing the state, but vilified for her actions in seizing imperial power. Wu Zetian or Emperor Wu was in a special position. She had two husbands who were Emperors - Emperor Taizong and his son, Emperor Gaozong. She herself became Emperor Wu and had three sons and a grandson who also became Emperors. She came from the Wu family clan who were relatively well-off. Her father, Wu Shihuo, was engaged in the timber business. He was appointed as the Duke of Ying for serving as an army commander to the Li Family.

Subsequently he was appointed as Minister of Revenue and superintendent of Jingzhou City at Lizhou.

Wu Mei Niang was born at Jingzhou City. Her ancestral tomb was believed to have tapped into the Feng Shui of the landform of Lizhou. Located in the Southwestern part of China, it was known as the "Gateway to the North of Sichuan" and the "Golden Triangle of Sichuan." The terrain of Lizhou is high at the Northeast and Northwest, with a mountainous area in the North. The central area is made up of shallow valleys and flatland and there are low mountainous areas in the south which serve as the Table Mountain. The Jialing River flows down harmoniously from here. This special geographic environment falls into the Later

Heaven Kun Gua and Early Heaven Xùn Gua. The whole environment is open to the south, which is Li Gua, bringing fortune to women. The Qi from the Northwest, Qian Gua, and Northeast, Gen Gua, which bring good fortune to men, is blocked due to the higher terrain. In the old days, the only way for a woman to achieve greatness was through marriage. Thus, Wu Mei Niang was sent to the Palace to be the concubine of the Emperor Taizong.

Once Yuan Tian-Gang, a well-known Feng Shui master, wandered through Lizhou, and saw Wu Mei Niang dressed as a boy. Surprised he predicted aloud that Wu Mei Niang had the “Dragon Eye Phoenix Neck” showing Noble Qi. Regretfully he said,

his Luopan and buried a copper coin in the ground as a marker. He then reported his finding to Wu Zetian.

Li Chunfeng began his search by hiking over Yinshan, passing the prairie and going toward the East along the Wei River. Unexpectedly, he found a prominent strange stone mountain at Qinchuan. From afar, this mountain looked like a sleeping beauty, lying in the sky and clouds. The head is formed by lush forests with two slender legs slightly tilted. Even more amazingly, it actually has a pair of peaks rising from it, forming the shape of breasts. He quickly went up the mountain and stabbed a lock of hair deeply into the soil. He then reported his finding to Wu Zetian.

Later, he found out that Wu Mei Niang had fulfilled his prediction by becoming Emperor Wu of the Zhou Dynasty.

Yuan Tian-Gang was appointed together with Li Chunfeng as Imperial Astronomers to search for the best resting place for Emperor Gaozong.

Yuan Tiangang searched the two sides of the Yellow River to no avail. When he reached Guanzhong, an astronomical phenomena appeared in the night sky. He saw a purple sky on the mountain, intersecting with the Big Dipper. Yuan Tiangang knew that the phenomena had shown him a treasure spot, so he hurriedly pinpointed the position with

Both of them reported that the best location for the Mausoleum had been identified in Liangshan County. An envoy was sent to check on the findings. Yuan Tian-Gang and Li Chunfeng pointed out the same spot on the mountainside of the main peak of Liangshan. The envoy asked: "How do you know?" Yuan Tian-Cang said he buried a coin at the spot, while Li Chun-Feng said he planted a lock of hair there.

The envoy dug up soil and was taken taken aback. : Li Chunfeng's lock of hair was found threaded through the hole in Yuan Tiangang's buried copper coin. Is this coincidence or God's will?

The spot became the Qianling Mausoleum

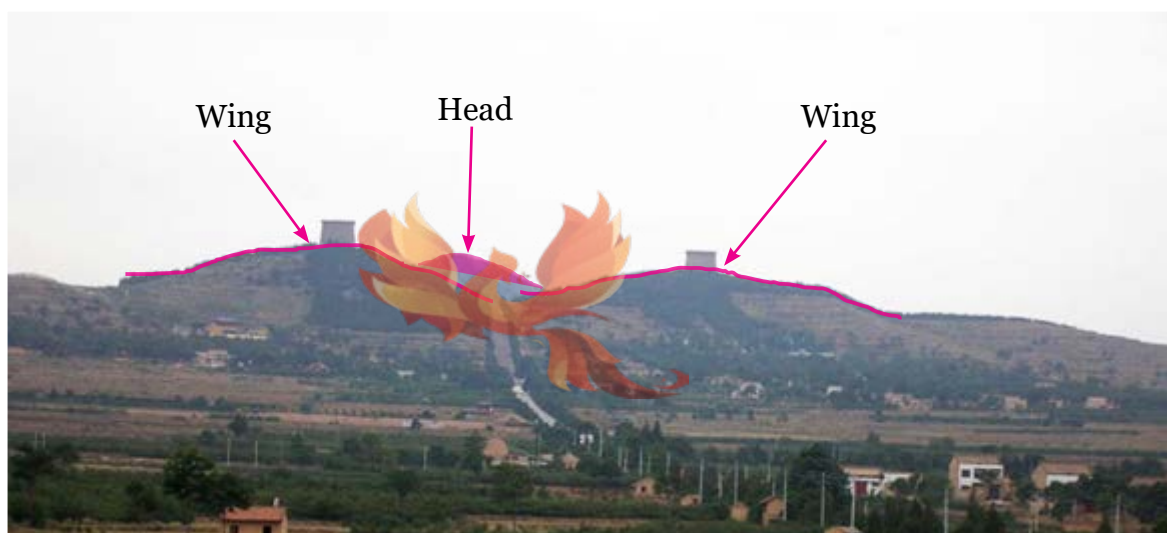


in Qian County, Shaanxi province. The Qianling Mausoleum overlooks the meridian mountain which is known as the Phoenix Rising Formation. It has a very large bright hall in the front where Qi is collected. The tomb consists of three peaks, with two at the southern side and a higher peak at the Northern side. The two peaks at the Southern part are said to look like a woman's breasts. This formation is also known as "Sunken Head Heavenly Wealth Star."

At the highest peak of the Northern area, the Flat Land Formation becomes visible. The prairie that Li Chunfeng passed by is a sunken spot overlooked by the highest peak. According to the Flat Land Dragon

principles, the highest points where the Qi is concentrated is the meridian spot. This macro-environment formed the "Phoenix Rising to the Sky" special structure.

Although Wu Zetian's Zhou Dynasty rose and fell under her reign, she is remembered forever as the only woman Emperor in China's history. The government under her rule was sound, there were no rebellions, abuses in the army and administration were stamped out and Korea was annexed. Not many emperors in China's history can claim to achieve these feats. Besides her achievements, Feng Shui also plays a part in her lasting fame.



CHARACTERISTICS OF THE 十神 TEN GODS (THE INFLUENCE ELEMENT)

There are altogether 10 types of Day Masters arising from the two different polarities (Yin and Yang) of the Five Elements. In the previous issues, we have shown how the Ten Gods are derived from the interaction of the Five Elements with the Day Master. Each of these Five Elements can support, destroy, control, or exhaust one another. Moving forward, we will be exploring the characteristic of the Ten Gods.

In this issue's Bazi 101, we want to explore the characteristics of the Influence element. The Influence element is the element that controls the Day Master. The Influence element is further divided into Yin and Yang polarities, resulting in the Direct Officer and Seven Killings stars. Due to the different polarities, the characteristics of the Direct Officer and Seven Killings stars are also different.

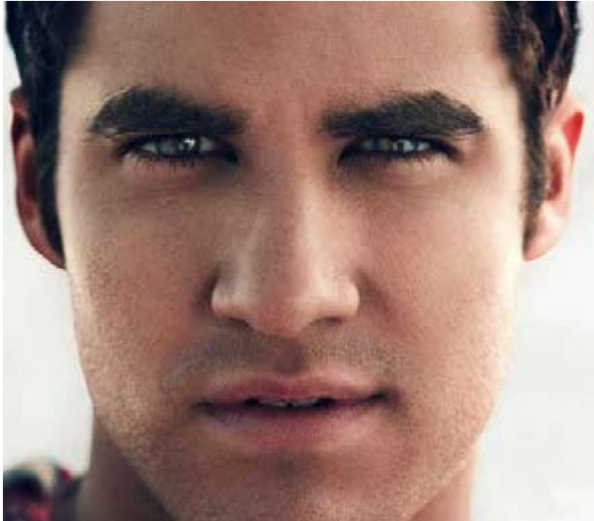
FACE READING: WHAT DO YOUR EYEBROWS SAY ABOUT YOU?

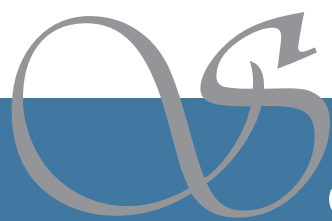
whether you are actually in the right state of mind.

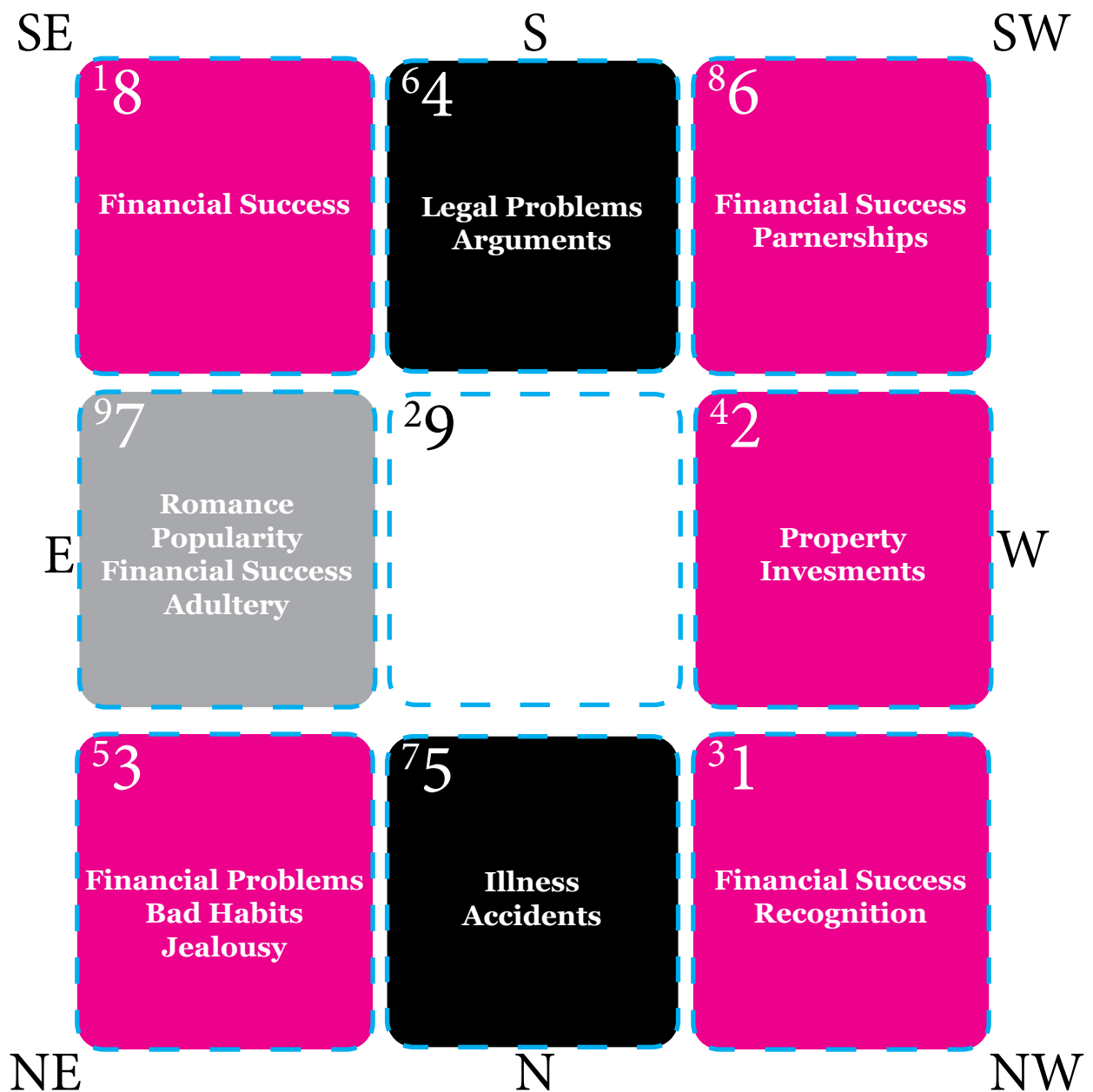

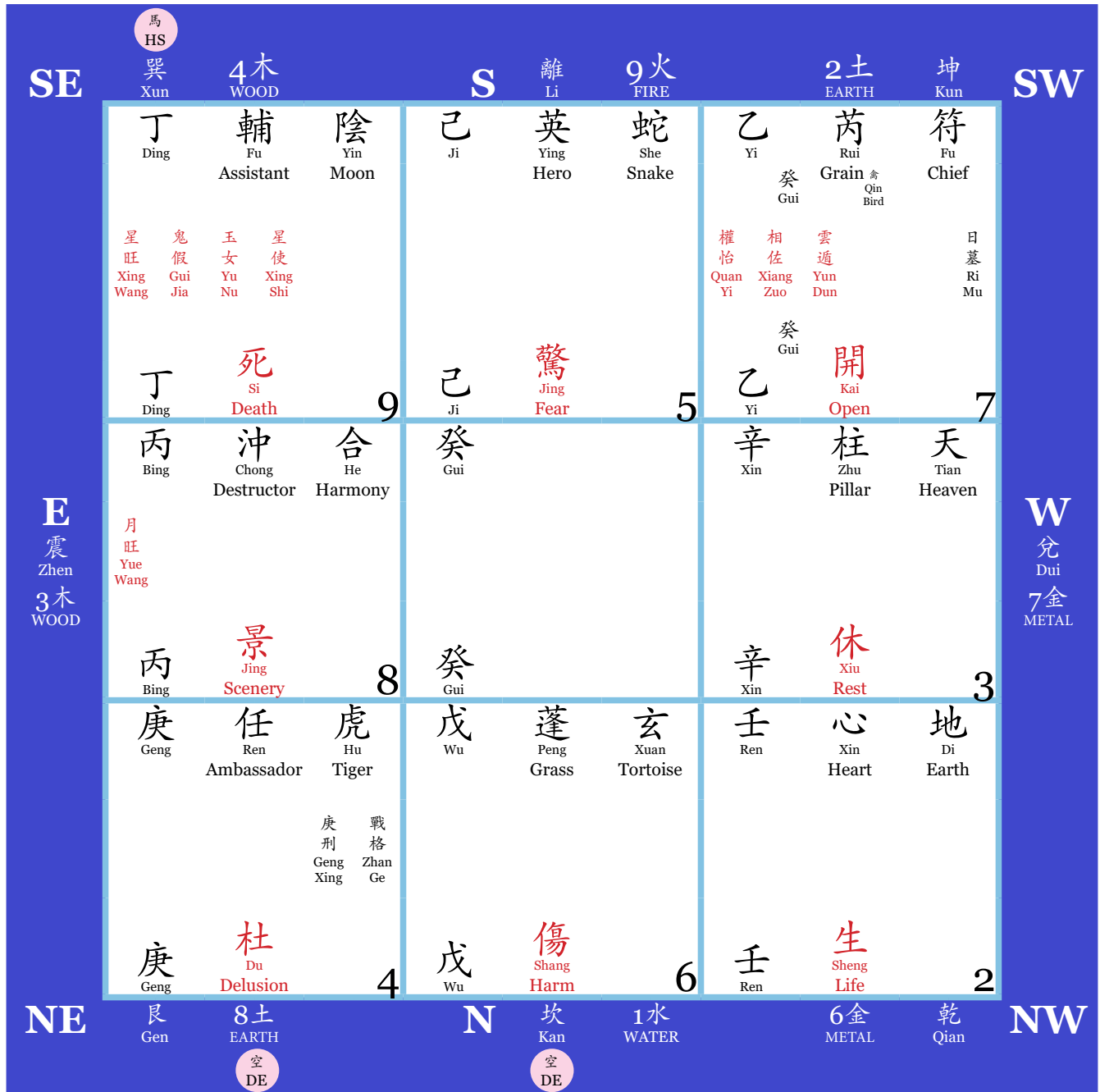

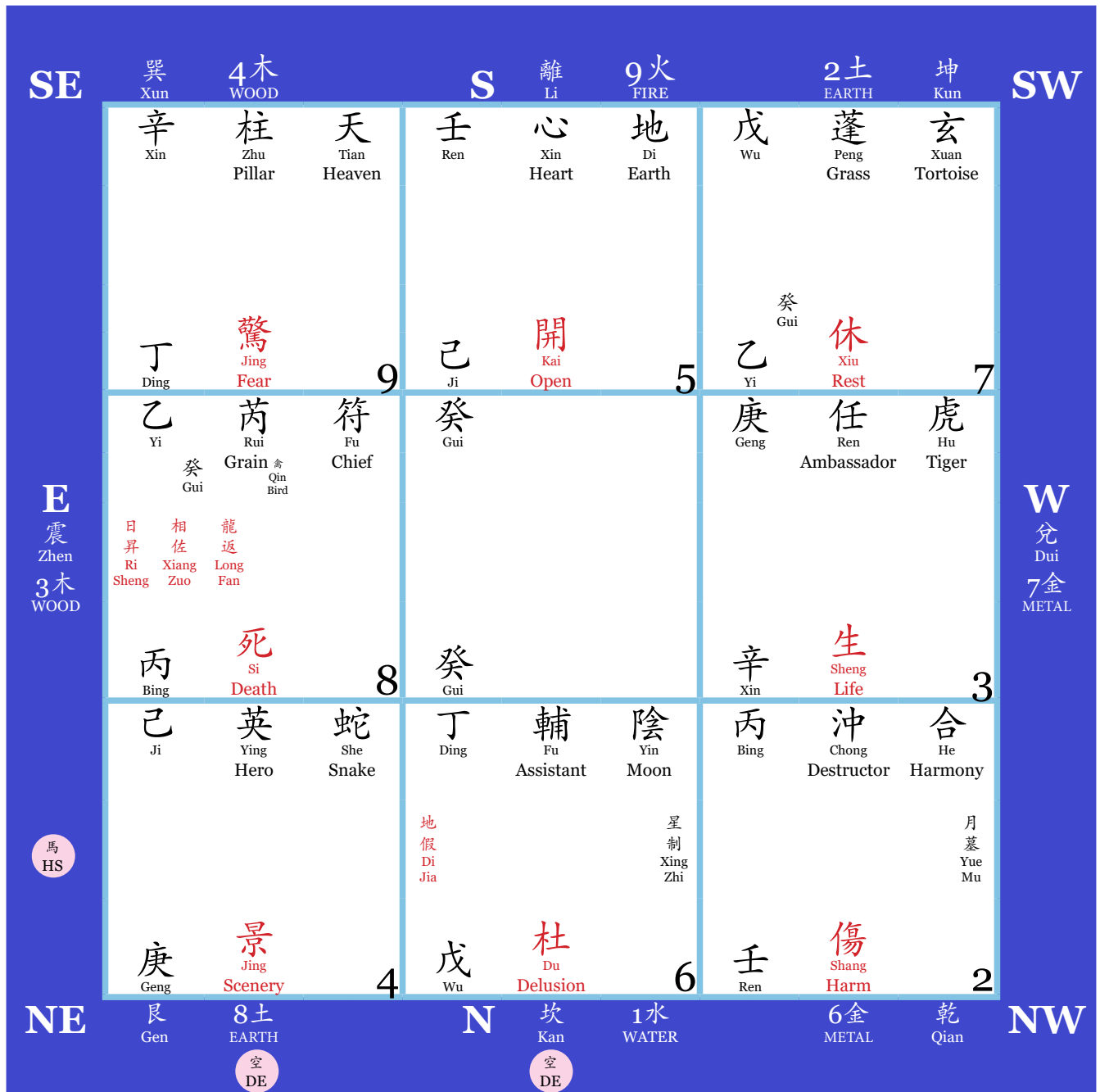
